JAMAICA

PORTS / BORDERS STATUS: **OPEN**

- COVID-19 RT-PCR swab test required for travelers from US, Brazil, Dominican Republic, and Mexico. Negative test results should be no older than 10 days from the date of arrival and must be uploaded to the [Travel Authorization form](#).
 - All travelers must complete and submit a [Travel Authorization form](#) a maximum of 5 days prior to arrival.
 - Travel with a printed or electronic copy of the [Travel Authorization form](#) and a printed copy of the negative COVID-19 RT-PCR swab test result.
 - Failure to comply will result in denied entry.

ST. LUCIA

PORTS / BORDERS STATUS: **OPEN**

- COVID-19 RT-PCR swab test required for all travelers. Negative test results should be no older than 7 days from the expected date of arrival.
- All travelers must submit a [Pre-Arrival Registration form](#) online prior to arrival.
- Travel with a printed copy of the [Pre-Arrival Registration form](#) and the negative COVID-19 RT-PCR swab test result.
- Failure to comply will result in denied entry.

ANTIGUA

PORTS / BORDERS STATUS: **OPEN**

- COVID-19 PCR test required for all travelers. Negative test results should be no older than 7 days from the expected date of arrival.
 - All Travelers must submit a [Traveler Accommodation form](#) online prior to arrival.
 - Travel with a printed copy of the negative COVID-19 RT-PCR swab test result.
 - Failure to comply will result in denied entry.

BARBADOS

PORTS / BORDERS STATUS: **OPEN**

- All travelers are strongly encouraged to take a COVID-19 PCR test 72 hours prior to travel and travel with proof of results.
 - Travelers without a documented negative COVID-19 RT-PCR swab test result from an accredited or recognized laboratory will be required to take a test upon arrival.
 - Travelers are required to complete the online [Immigration and Customs form](#) 72 hours prior to arrival.

GRENADA

PORTS / BORDERS STATUS: **OPEN**

- COVID-19 PCR test required for all travelers. Negative test results should be no older than 7 days from the expected date of arrival.
- All travelers must complete a [Travel Health form and waiver of liability](#) prior to arrival.
- Travel with a printed copy of the [Travel Health form and waiver of liability](#) and the negative COVID-19 PCR test result.
- Failure to comply will result in denied entry.
